

## Responsibilities of Intergroup Representatives

Thank you for taking on the position in your home group to be your group's representative to the Wilmington Area Intergroup! We look forward to working with you so Intergroup can continue to serve all the groups and members of the AA community in helping the alcoholic who still suffers.

Here are a few things to keep in mind as you begin your service:

1. Attend Full Council Meetings! The Full Council meets every other month (January, March, May, July, September, and November) at 5:30 at the Fellowship Center. If you can't attend, please send your alternate. Your participation is the **ONLY** way we know what your group's concerns are and how we can better serve you.
2. Communicate Intergroup activities, growth and current problems to your group. If there's something going on, please talk to your group!
3. Recruit volunteers from your home group for twelfth step work and other Intergroup activities, such as Alkathons, Founders Day Picnic, annual gratitude dinner, etc. Intergroup can always use volunteers to answer the phones (including the Night Owl phone), assemble Where & When's, and other office-related activities.
4. Vote your group's conscience at each meeting. You are the **ONLY** vote your group has on issues affecting Intergroup.
5. Become familiar with the Intergroup Bylaws. **The Bylaws govern not only the work of the Board, but also the Full Council.** See ARTICLE VI, SECTION III for Intergroup reps.
